Initiated а new project with Emerging partnering Wildlife Conservation Leaders (EWCL) to launch the Amphibian Report Card, an educational and collaborative tool to support amphibian conservation efforts. By crowdsourcing expert input, the Amphibian Report Cards aim to provide both an assessment of the conservation status of U.S. Amphibian species as well as recommendations on how to contribute to their conservation. FCSal now maintains this database and hopes this can further our mission to increase awareness about salamander diversity, biology, and conservation. 


